

AUCKLAND AIRPORT – CONDITIONS OF USE PROCEDURE FOR MOVING / REMOVING AIRCRAFT

In the event that we are required to move/remove an aircraft as a result of a failure by you to comply with an instruction from us to you under these Conditions to do so:

1. We will, where applicable, follow the procedures for the recovery of disabled aircraft set out in our Aerodrome Emergency Plan Manual and other relevant operational instructions.
2. In other cases, we will provide you with as much notice as is, in all the circumstances, reasonably practicable:
 - (a) that we intend to move/remove the aircraft;
 - (b) of the proposed location to which the aircraft is to be relocated;
 - (c) of the means by which we intend to move/remove the aircraft; and
 - (d) of any other conditions which may apply to your recovery of the aircraft.
3. In the event that the notice referred to in paragraph 2 is not practicable we will notify you, as soon as possible:
 - (a) that we have moved/removed the aircraft;
 - (b) of the location to which the aircraft has been moved; and
 - (c) of any conditions which may apply to your recovery of the aircraft.
